Luke 3:1-6 Preparing the way

Compare these two scenes. First, picture the flurry of anxiety that happens when a foreign dignitary - president, prime minister or pope – visits your country. They are welcomed with a red carpet, leaders greet them, streets are cleared to whisk them to a reception, and they are given the finest accommodation with catering to match. Now, imagine an asylum seeker arriving at a port or airport. In Ireland for example, they are brought to a reception centre, and then moved to a direct provision centre to await a decision on their application – a process that often takes years. Yes, they have shelter and food, but they have limited freedom and few opportunities for involvement in society. The system has been rightly criticised as in humane. This is just one snapshot of the unequal world we live in. Those brought up in poverty, homelessness, war or direct provision have a difficult road ahead. The system is stacked against them.

Today we meet John the Baptist, whose task is to 'prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight', such a messenger might do for a queen or king or some other VIP. John' was a radical voice, urging people to open their eyes and change their hearts. What if we changed our hearts this Advent by reaching out and removing the obstacles in front of people? What if we 'prepared the way' for Jesus by smoothing the path for others, tearing down the walls of prejudice in our hearts and the walls in society that keep people apart, even one brick at a time? As individuals and Church, we can be the 'voice in the wilderness' calling for and bringing about change.
