KILTEGAN CAMOGIE 50 Years ago 1975



After the success of the under 16's winning Championship and League double the club looked forward to 1975 and held their AGM in St. Tegan's Hall on the 25th March and elected the following officers: President Mrs. Hugh Byrne, Chairperson Mary Lawlor, Vice Chairperson Bernie Kelly, Secretary Ann Rafferty, Joint Treasurers Mrs Coogan, Carrigeen and Mrs. Carthy, Talbotstown. Club trainer Nat Pearson, Selectors Nat Pearson, Hugh Rafferty, Bernie Kelly. Captain Senior team Mary Lawlor & Patrica Kelly. Also in March Ann Aspell was appointed as under 16 County Selector, Hugh Rafferty was appointed a Junior County Selector. A total of eight Kiltegan players were selected for the Wicklow Camogie panel, they were Bernie Kelly, Ann Lawlor, Mary Lawlor, Patrice Kelly, Lucy Whelan, Bernie O'Toole, Breda Whelan, Jane Clynch. With a record number on the panel it just went to show how much this young club had improved since their formation in 1971. Hard work and dedication by all the players and trojan work by Hugh Rafferty, his wife Nancy, Nat Pearson, Mary Lawlor had brought this club to the top. The club was run on a shoestring with very little fund raising done only a couple of events during the year. The team started training in late February and the hard training began to pay off when in April, Kiltegan defeated county kingpins Annacurra in the Senior League on a score line of Kiltegan 3-00 Annacurra 0-02, from the start of the game this team took control and ran out easy winners. This would be the start of a great year for the club.

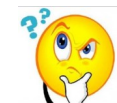
